April 2015



Pulp and Paper Manufacturer Doubles Water Purification Capacity While Reducing Wastewater and Energy Use

PHOENIX, March 5, 2015 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- Arizona-based paper manufacturer Doubletree Paper Mills started up a new state of the art water treatment for their expanded manufacturing operation in Gila Bend in 2014. The new integrated water treatment system, supplied by Massachusetts-based Desalitech, increases its water production capacity by 100% to 400 gallons per minute while drastically reducing wastewater production and energy use.

The environmentally conscious manufacturing company replaced their existing conventional reverse osmosis units with Desalitech ReFlex Reverse Osmosis systems featuring CCD technology. This new installation boosts water recovery on their high-purity process water stream to 90%, reducing wastewater production by almost a factor of three while reducing energy use by nearly 25%.
